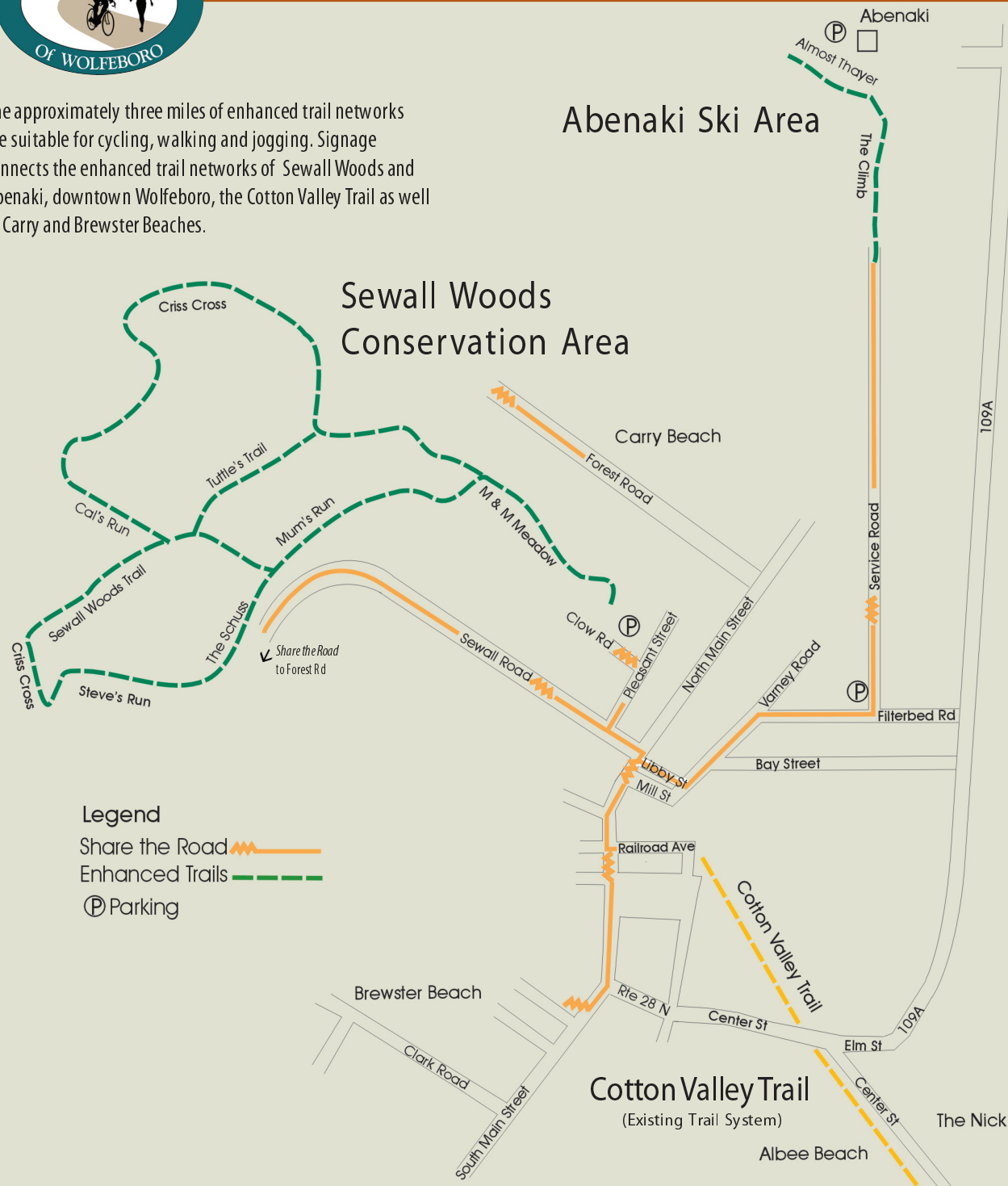




Preserving the Local Environment and Enhancing the Quality of Life
