How do I apply for help?

A Municipal Welfare Assistance Application must be completed to receive assistance. The Welfare Director will assess your current situation, and set you up for an appointment and inform you the required documentation you will need. Municipal Welfare Assistance Applications are available at the Welfare Office located at 258 South Main Street in All Saint's Church Outreach building.

Do you provide housing?

The Town of Wolfeboro Welfare Department does not provide housing, but will refer the applicant to housing resources including homeless shelters, housing authorities, and local housing providers. What is Fuel Assistance and how do I apply for?
