Public Input Session

Jim Pineo reviewed the Powerpoint presentation (attached) for the Public Input Session scheduled for June 9, 2022 @ 6:00PM in the Great Hall. Chief Rondeau identified his name was missing from the committee members slide. Jim noted that on slide 30 the side needed the building estimated footprint installed.

Bob Loughman enquired what would be going in front of the CIP. Jim Pineo advised that this depended upon information received from the public input session and it is difficult to assign a cost to the Citizens Bank Building at this time because we do not have enough information, however there would be a project brought forward in 2023. Jim Pineo stated his priorities for the upcoming years were: PSB, South Main Street, Roads, Grant funded projects. Bob Tougher mentioned he believes the budget committee might not entertain any projects of financial significance. Chief Rondeau mentioned the time is now to bring this project forward and let the voters decide. Jim Pineo stated that he would insert a slide which would provide the estimated tax rate impact for various projects. Chief Zotti felt the project needed to be presented to the citizen for a vote. Steve Wood discussed the School and how there were a multiple votes until the project passed.

The committee discussed holding meeting on June 13 to discuss the result and present findings to the Board of Selectmen.
